#### ORIGIN:

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2 On 02-25-09 at approximately 1758 hours, I responded to a radio call of a traffic accident

involving a vehicle and a bicycle rider at College Boulevard and Vista Way. Officer Fullen and

Officer Munoz also responded.

#### OFFICERS OBSERVATIONS AND ACTIONS:

Upon arrival I observed three males standing in front of a red Jeep which was stopped in between the number 1 and number 2 left turn lane from College Boulevard to Vista Way. I observed a bicycle on the ground in front of the vehicle which appeared to have been run over. Upon walking up to the scene I was approached by a male, later identified by California driver's license as Trevor Hudson (witness), who stated "That guy in the Jeep intentionally ran him over." I contacted Martin Rios (victim), identified by California identification card, and took his statement. Rios was holding his right shoulder and told me he thought it was dislocated. OFD arrived on scene but Rios declined medical attention and stated he would go to the hospital on his own.

I contacted the driver of the vehicle Michael Shields III (suspect), identified by his California driver's license, and took his statement. I returned to Hudson and took his full statement. All parties stated that Rios and Shields were in an argument prior to the incident and Rios had spit on Shields vehicle before Rios was run over. After taking all parties statements, I observed the

- 1 damage to the front of Shield's vehicle and the marks on the road and center divider. The damage
- and marks were consistent with Rios' and Hudson's statement that Shields had intentionally run 2
- Rios over with his vehicle. 3
- 4 Based on the evidence at the scene coupled with Hudson's and Rios' statements, I
- 5 determined that Shields had used his vehicle as a weapon and intentionally run over Rios. I placed
- Shields under arrest at the scene for PC 245(a)(1) Assault with a deadly weapon. FET Medford 6
  - responded and took photographs of the scene and collected evidence. Shields vehicle was towed
  - from the scene by S&R Towing per CVC22651(h)(1)- driver arrested.
- 9 I transported Shields to OPD for processing. While at OPD I admonished Shields of his
- 10 rights per Miranda. Shields answered "Yes" and "Yes" and provided me with a full statement.
- 11 Shields was later transported to VDF by Rancho Santa Fe.
- 12 I later responded to TCMC and took photographs of Rios' injuries which FET Calderwood
- 13 later booked into OPD.

#### 15 STATEMENTS:

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#### Statement of Martin Rios (Victim):

Rios essentially stated the following: He was riding his bike eastbound on Barnard Drive approaching College Boulevard. He stated that he was slightly in the road, outside of the bike lane.

Rios said shields passed him and almost hit him with his car. Shields turned southbound on College 1

Boulevard, Rios also turned southbound and caught up to Shields just before the light at Vista Way. 2

Rios was upset about Shields almost hitting him so he pulled up next to the driver side of his car and 3

spit on it. Rios stated that Shields cursed at him from inside the vehicle, turned the wheel in his

direction, punched the gas, and ran him over. Rios was dragged across two lanes and over the center 5

divider. Rios was able get out from under the vehicle and call the police. Rios desired prosecution

against Shields for intentionally running him over for his vehicle.

#### Statement of Michael Shields (Suspect):

Shields essentially stated the following on scene pre-Miranda: He was traveling castbound on Barnard Drive. Rios was riding his bike in the center of the road. Shields past him and turned south on College Boulevard. Shields approached the light at Vista Way. Rios rode his bike next to Shields driver side and began to spit on and hit his car while still riding straight. Shields attempted to turn and accelerate past Rios and accidentally ran him over.

Shields essentially stated the following post Miranda: He was traveling eastbound on Barnard Drive. Rios was riding his bike in the center of the road swerving back and forth so vehicle could not pass him. Shields eventually passed Rios on the right side and turned southbound on College Boulevard. Shields stated that he was slightly close to Rios when he passed him. When

1 Shields passed Rios, Rios threw his hands in the air. Shields approached Vista Way and got in the

2 number two turn lane to turn eastbound on Vista Way. Shields was traveling slowly due to the

traffic. Rios rode his bike up next to Shield's driver door and began to curse at shields. Rios spit on

4 Shield's vehicle and attempted to kick it while still riding his bike, Shields attempted to turn and

accelerate away from Rios when he kicked at his vehicle causing Rios to fall and get run over.

6 Shields exited his vehicle and was immediately approached by Hudson and Rios who began to curse

at him. Shields heard Hudson say "Martin are you alright." Shields told them it was not intentional

and told them to wait till police arrived.

#### Statement of Trevor Hudson (Witness):

Hudson essentially stated the following: He was riding his motorcycle eastbound on Barnard Drive behind Rios and Shields. He saw Rios riding his bike in the street. He saw Shields swerve at Rios as he passed him and almost hit him. Shields turned southbound on College Boulevard and Rios chased after him on his bike. Rios pulled up parallel to Shields and they began to argue back and forth. Hudson saw Shields turn the steering wheel towards Rios, accelerate his vehicle, and run Rios over dragging him across two lanes and over the curb. Hudson pulled his bike in front of Shields vehicle and confronted Shields. Hudson asked Shields why he had run Rios over and

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#### NARRATIVE

On 02-25-2009 at 1811 hours, I responded to a radio call for an FET at a scene of a traffic accident involving a vehicle and a bicyclist. When I arrived Officers Fullen and Munoz were on scene. Officer Fullen told me the accident was being investigated as a PC 245, assault with a deadly weapon.

Officer Fullen walked me through the scene and pointed out the suspect vehicle, a red colored 2008 Jeep Liberty with California license plate 6DZA062. The vehicle had come to a stop in the two left turn lanes of north bound College to east bound Vista Way. On the center median in front of the Jeep was a damaged bicycle. I observed the bicycle had a bent and broken front and rear tires and the frame had been damaged.

Officer Fullen also pointed out a smearing on the left side of the front bumper. I inspected the smearing and observed what appeared to be a latent hand smear on the hood of the car. The smearing had no visible minutia to lift. I observed that the front license plate had been bent.

I took digital photographs of the scene. I first took overall north bound photographs of the north bound lanes of College Blvd showing the roadway and the left turn pocket. I then took additional overall photographs and I walked into the scene showing the relation of the car with the bicycle.

I took an identification photograph of the rear license plate on the car. I then took overall exterior and interior photographs of the ear. I also took overall photographs of the front license plate and of the latent hand smear on top of the car.

I then took overall and close up photographs of the areas marked by Officer Fullen on the roadway and the center median. I then took overall and close up photographs of the "HARD" bicycle. I also took an identification photograph of the bicycle ID number X24W8D0208. I also took an orientation photograph of the street sign and the intersection of Vista Way and College Blvd.
